Synonym

- Pay attention to part of speech! It's only a synonym if the parts of speech match. A verb cannot be a synonym for a noun and vice versa.

Antonym

- Pay attention to part of speech! It's only a antonym if the parts of speech match. A verb cannot be a antonym for a noun and vice versa.

Part and Whole

- Only applicable if you're dealing with noun:noun.
- The part has to be essential to the whole. Look at your examples.

Characteristic Quality

- Refers to noun: adj. and vice versa

Classification

- Refers to noun:noun
- Also, refers to a type of... (Look at examples!)

Cause and Effect

- Refers to noun:noun
- Remember **E**ffect is a noun. **A**ffect is a verb.

Function

- noun: verb or vice versa
- Refers specifically to objects and their purpose

Location

- noun:noun

Degree

- Once again, pay attention to part of speech. They have to match.
- Refers to a scale or spectrum. Look at examples!

Performer and Related Object

- noun:noun
- Refers specifically to a person or title

Performer and Related Action

- noun:verb
- Refers specifically to a person or title

Action and Related Object

- verb:noun or vice versa
